Small arms and light weapons are a threat to both social and economic development of a community

Montenegrin Minister of the Interior Ivan Brajović, the Head of the OSCE Mission to Montenegro Sarunas Adomavicius and the UNDP Representative Alexander Avanesov evaluated that uncontrollable spreading and owning of small arms and light weapons pose a threat to both social and economic development of the community and the society as a whole. They signed the Memorandum of Understanding which defines the cooperation and obligations of the Ministry, OSCE and UNDP with the goal of enhancing the capacity of law enforcement in the area of control and reduction of small arms and light weapons (SALW). Minister Brajović stated there are close to 105 thousand registered firearms in Montenegro and Avanesov added that such huge amount of weapons represents a barrier for its development, stressing that most of these SALW ought to be destroyed or at least put under control. Adomavicius underlined that SALW should not be forgot in terms of organized crime and terrorism as well. He announced the Mission will address this issue via public campaigns, educational programmes, information for teachers and parents, open forums and discussions.
