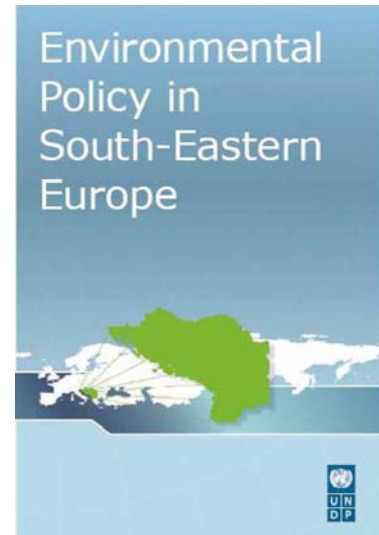

## Environmental Policy in South-Eastern Europe, first of its kind Report for the Region

**What:** The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) Montenegro will present the Environmental Policy in South-Eastern Europe Report, and the Ministry of Tourism and Environmental Protection of the Government of Montenegro will provide a brief commentary on behalf of all the countries/territories involved in the Report. This document should help the Environment Ministers and other decision makers in South-Eastern Europe, the EU, donor countries, international organizations and other interested parties in profiling decisions regarding their engagement in the areas covered by the Report.

This Report covers the period from 2000 until today. Its purpose is to provide an overview of the progress towards the development and implementation of environmental and sustainability policy in South-Eastern Europe (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, FYR Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia and Kosovo - UN administered territory under UN Security Council Resolution 1244). **No similar Report on this Region has been made so far.**



*The Environmental Policy in South-Eastern Europe Report is complementary with the Europe's Environment: The Fourth Assessment prepared by the European Environment Agency (EEA) and Policies for a Better Environment - Progress in Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia (EECCA) prepared by the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD).*

*All three Reports will sequentially be presented by high EEA, OECD and UNDP officials and high-ranking officials of the Europe and CIS.*

The Environmental Policy in South-Eastern Europe Report will be presented by **Mr. Garret Tankosić Kelly, UNDP Resident Representative a.i./UN Interagency Focal Point in Montenegro and commented by his guest, Mr. Predrag Nenezić, Minister of Tourism and Environmental Protection of Montenegro.**
