The Learning Workshops Programme entails specialized lectures, workshops and panel discussions in four domains: war crime trials, reparations to civil war victims, reform of state institutions and establishing of the truth in relation to past events. Lecturers and moderators are eminent experts in the field of transitional justice from the countries in the region and abroad. Participants are leading parliamentaries and representatives of judiciaries from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Kosovo, Montenegro and Serbia.

The Transitional Justice Programme aims to strengthen the capacities for research, training, establishing of partnerships, regional exchange of information and public information capacities of post-conflict social institutions, therefore providing access to justice. The Programme is tailored with an intention to offer strategic advice and support to the efforts of the governments in the region in overcoming the past and in creating conditions for better regional cooperation and development.
