Montenegro

UN Assistant Secretary General and UNDP Assistant Administrator Kalman Mizsei to visit Montenegro

What: The United Nations Assistant Secretary General & United Nations Development Programme Assistant Administrator and Director for Europe and the CIS, Mr. Kalman Mizsei will pay a visit to Montenegro.

While in Montenegro, Mr. Mizsei will meet with H.E. President of the Republic of Montenegro Mr. Filip Vujanović, H.E. President of Parliament Mr. Ranko Krivokapić, H.E. Prime Minister Mr. Milo Đukanović, and H.E. Minister of Foreign Affairs Mr. Miodrag Vlahović.

Besides discussion on UNDP's cooperation with Montenegrin Government, public institutions and civil society organizations in sustainable development domains such as social inclusion, environmentally sensitive economic growth and capacity building of key institutions, the official talks with the state's highest officials will also focus on the following:

Mr. Mizsei will congratulate President Vujanović on Montenegro's achieving independence through a peaceful and democratic process, becoming in this way the 192nd United Nations Member State. Also, he will convey a message that UNDP Office in Montenegro will continue to place its programming in line with the European Union's support to Montenegro and European integration.

With President of The Parliament Krivokapić he will discuss the recent signing of Memorandum of Understanding to support the citizens' participation through elected representatives in the Parliament.

Discussions on UNDP's potential support in defining of strategic priorities for sustainable development in Montenegro and possible support to organization of strategic conference in order to ensure international assistance in realization of these priorities will be one of main topics in a meeting with Prime Minister Đukanović.

Minister of Foreign Affairs Vlahović and Mr. Mizsei will discuss UNDP's support to this Ministry in improving capacities to report on international Conventions, Treaties and other commitments, including the Millennium Declaration.
