### Closing of the Workshop on the Doing Business Indicators

**What:** Between October 26<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> the Ministry of Finance and Capacity Development Programme (CDP<sup>1</sup>) organized a workshop with an aim to inform the representatives of state institutions and public and private sectors of the methodology of 2010 Doing Business report indicators as well as of IFC (International Finance Corporation) recommendations on further reform steps in creating better regulation and favorable business environment in Montenegro.

Beside presentation of 2010 Doing Business Report and analyses of indicators and methodologies, the IFC's recommendations for further reform in domains covered by the Report, nine indicators were also presented: starting a business, construction permits, registering property, getting credit, protecting investors, paying taxes, trading across borders, contract enforcement, and closing a business.
