### Workshop on the Doing Business Indicators

**What:** Representatives of the Ministry of Finance and Capacity Development Programme (CDP<sup>1</sup>) will organize a workshop with an aim to inform the representatives of state institutions and business associations with the methodology of 2010 Doing Business report indicators as well as of IFC (International Finance Corporation) recommendations on further reform steps in creating better regulation and favorable business environment in Montenegro.
