### **Fourth Montenegrin Summer School for Young Diplomats "Gavro Vuković" 6 – 11 July 2011**

**What:** The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and European Integration of Montenegro, with the support of the Capacity Development Programme (CDP), the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Norway, will organize the Fourth Montenegrin Summer School for Young Diplomats "Gavro Vuković", that will take place from 6 – 11 July 2011. **Participants will be young diplomats from thirty five countries of the world, while lecturers will be prominent practitioners and theoreticians of the international politics.**

The Fourth Montenegrin Summer School for Young Diplomats is dedicated to diplomacy as a factor of security, stability and development in a changing environment, and it represents an excellent opportunity to exchange opinions and share experiences related to the current security, political and economic aspects of development. At the same time, this is an opportunity for socializing and interaction between young diplomats, which will additionally contribute to their professional development.

At the Summer School the participants will particularly deal with the topics such as: diplomacy of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century – trends and innovations, key skills and challenges in diplomacy, effective communications, country image and reputation, public diplomacy, relations with the media, European Union, diplomacy and security, etc.. The lecturers will be prominent professors from the Diplomatic Academy of Vienna and the Clingendael Institute of Hague, ambassadors and experts from various domains of foreign policy. During the group work, participants will have an opportunity to exchange opinions and share experiences, as well as to provide concrete contribution to the discussion on the given topics.
