Questions and Answers

Q1: Under “scope of work” in your brief

Is ‘Film’s narration and subtitles/captions shall be prepared in both English and the languages officially spoken in the six mentioned countries/territories’ to be included in the offer?

A1: Yes, it should be included in the offer.

Q2: Under the main programme document it states:

“In order to achieve broader dissemination and public awareness raising in and among the countries, a documentary will be commissioned for each hot spot, describing the initial situation, project efforts and achieved results. The documentaries will be commissioned to production teams that are able to secure cost sharing in the production. These documentaries will be made available to all TV networks in the region and internationally in the final phase of the project.”

Has this plan been superseded by the requirement for one single film as per this tender? Or is this an extra or separate requirement?

A2: All requirements are stated in the Request for Proposal. No special or extra requirements are added to that.

Q3: In your brief.

You say: No voice-over will be edited over natural sound (IT tone). We presume you mean that it would not be MIXED with natural sound (thereby leaving a complete international track for other language versions).

A3: Yes, this is what we mean.

Q4: Is production of the documentary film acceptable in HDV format instead of HD? How would this affect the overall scoring?

A4: HDV is acceptable format indeed, however it could (not necessarily) affect the overall scoring
